The Marsh Christian Trust and the PMSA invite nominations for the Marsh Award for Excellence in Public Sculpture 2011. The £1,750 award can be won outright or shared, by a newly commissioned public sculpture* or restoration (unveiled or completed since 30 October 2009).

Please complete and post or email the form below, no later than 30 April 2011, having visited the site.

In addition, please provide:

- clear photographs/articles in publications or a web-link to a good quality online image
- a clear description
- details of the artist(s) or restorer(s).
- on a separate sheet your reasons for nominating (max.200 words)

Please note we exclude sculptural fountains from possible nominations since a separate Marsh Award covers them.

What counts as public sculpture? For the purposes of this award, anything sculptural or commemorative out of doors in the public eye is eligible except for works in churchyards (other than church-yard monuments that are erected by public subscription).

Pieces on display in a corporate setting can be considered, if visible from a public place.

Temporary pieces are eligible providing they are still on public display one year after the 2011 Award Ceremony (November 2012).

The award is for work on view in the UK, Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man. The final decision lies with the Award Committee and the winner(s) will be announced before the end of 2011.

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Eligibility Criteria

The Marsh Award for Excellence in Public Sculpture is the main award for public sculpture for the UK, Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man.

It seeks to promote awareness and dialogue about public sculpture, celebrate new works that show originality, artistic quality and merit, and a concern for their setting. Awards are also made to high quality, appropriate and sensitive restorations of existing works. With this in mind we invite nominations for the 2011 Marsh Award for Excellence in Public Sculpture.

Nominations are invited from:

- Members of the public
- Individual, affiliated or corporate members of the Public Monuments and Sculpture Association (PMSA). The current groups either affiliated to the PMSA or with a joint membership are:
 - Ancient Monuments Society
 - Art & Architecture
 - British Sundial Society
 - Fountain Society
 - Harlow Art Trust
 - Historic Gardens Association
 - Landscape and Arts Network
 - Royal British Society of Sculptors
 - Society of Portrait Sculptors
 - Twentieth Century Society
 - UK National Inventory of War Memorials
 - War Memorials Trust (formerly Friends of War Memorials)

Note: Sculptors are **not** allowed to nominate their own work

Nominators must have visited the site and seen the sculpture or monument.

Date of Works:

For the 2011 Award, sculptures or restorations must have been unveiled between 30 October 2009 and the closing date for nominations, 30 April 2011.

For the purposes of this award, anything sculptural or commemorative out of doors in the public eye is eligible except for works in churchyards (other than church-yard monuments that are erected by public subscription). Pieces on display in a corporate setting can be considered, if visible from a public place.
